From the Pastor's Desk



My dear parishioners,
We celebrate on this Sunday the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, one of the important tenets of our Christian faith. It is a great mystery as it is difficult to grasp and understand it fully, except by the light of Revelation. What is the mystery of the Holy Trinity?

What we know by Divine Revelation is that the Holy Trinity is the unity of three divine persons in one God. Our faith is a monotheistic faith, and not a polytheistic faith (which is the belief in a plurality of gods). We believe in one God, who is a unity of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The three divine persons (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) are distinct and different from one another, yet they share the same nature or the same Godhead. The Father is not the Son, the Son is not the Holy Spirit, and the Holy Spirit is neither the Father nor the Son. They are united in the bond of love in the one Godhead, and they work as one for the salvation of the world. When the Father creates, he does so with the Son and the Holy Spirit. When the Son saves, he does so with the Father and the Holy Spirit. When the Holy Spirit sanctifies, he does so with the Father and the Son.

To understand this better, we can look at the biblical Revelation. In the beginning of creation, God said, “let us make human beings in our image, after our likeness...” (Gen. 1:26a). Bible commentators have interpreted this plural form “let us” as the Father (Creator) speaking to the other persons of the Trinity, that is the Son and the Holy Spirit. In the beginning of the public ministry of the Lord Jesus, especially during his baptism, the voice of God spoke from heaven, “you are my beloved Son, with you I am well pleased”, and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form as a dove (Cf. Luke 3:22). It is a testimony that in the work of salvation carried out by the Lord Jesus, the Father and the Holy Spirit are also involved. When the Lord Jesus promised the Holy Spirit to the disciples, he said, “when the Advocate comes, whom I will send you from the Father, he will testify to me” (John 15:26). It also shows that in the work of the Holy Spirit to sanctify the Church, the Father and the Son are also involved.

As we are baptized “in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” (Cf. Mat. 28:19), we are drawn into the bond of love of the Holy Trinity, so that we may live in peace, harmony, and unity to build together our society, and to care for our common home, the earth. God bless you always.


Why is your participation important?



Solennité de la Sainte Trinité

Chers frères et sœurs,

Nous célébrons aujourd'hui la solennité de la Très Sainte Trinité, qui est une doctrine importante de notre foi chrétienne. C'est un grand mystère qui est difficile à saisir ou à comprendre pleinement, sauf par la lumière de la Révélation. C'est quoi le mystère de la Sainte Trinité ?

Ce que nous savons par la Révélation Divine, c'est que la Sainte Trinité est l'unité de trois personnes divines en un seul Dieu. Notre foi est une foi monothéiste et non une foi polythéiste (qui est la croyance en une pluralité de dieux). Nous croyons en un seul Dieu, qui est l'unité du Père, du Fils et du Saint-Esprit. Les trois personnes divines (Père, Fils et Saint-Esprit) sont distinctes et différentes les unes des autres, mais elles partagent la même nature ou la même Divinité. Le Père n'est pas le Fils, le Fils n'est pas le Saint-Esprit et le Saint-Esprit n'est ni le Père ni le Fils. Ils sont unis par le lien de l'amour en une seule Divinité et travaillent en union pour le salut du monde. Lorsque le Père crée, il le fait avec le Fils et le Saint-Esprit. Lorsque le Fils sauve, il le fait avec le Père et le Saint-Esprit. Lorsque le Saint-Esprit sanctifie, il le fait avec le Père et le Fils.

Pour mieux comprendre cela, nous pouvons regarder la Révélation biblique. Au début de la création, Dieu a dit : « *Faisons l'homme à notre image, selon notre ressemblance...* » (Genèse 1 : 26a). Les commentateurs de la Bible ont interprété cette forme plurielle « faisons » comme le Père (Créateur) s'adressant aux autres personnes de la Trinité, c'est-à-dire le Fils et le Saint-Esprit. Au début du ministère public du Seigneur Jésus, en particulier lors de son baptême, la voix de Dieu parla du ciel : « *Tu es mon Fils bien-aimé, en toi je trouve ma joie* », et le Saint-Esprit descendit sur lui sous une apparence corporelle, comme une colombe (Cf. Luc 3, 22). C'est un témoignage qui montre que dans l'œuvre du salut accomplie par le Seigneur Jésus, le Père et le Saint-Esprit sont également impliqués. Lorsque le Seigneur Jésus a promis le Saint-Esprit à ses disciples, il a dit : « *Quand viendra le Défenseur, que je vous enverrai d'auprès du Père, lui, l'Esprit de vérité qui procède du Père, il rendra témoignage en ma faveur* » (Jean 15 : 26). Cela montre également que dans l'œuvre du Saint-Esprit pour sanctifier l'Église, le Père et le Fils sont également impliqués.

En étant baptisés « *au nom du Père, et du Fils et du Saint-Esprit* » (Cf. Mat. 28, 19), nous entrons dans le lien d'amour de la Sainte Trinité, pour vivre dans la paix, l'harmonie et l'unité pour construire ensemble notre société et prendre soin de notre maison commune, la terre. Que Dieu vous bénisse toujours.
